To apply for SCONUL Access:

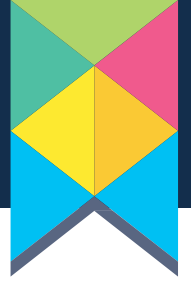
- First, complete the two steps below and click 'Find'

- Click 'Apply for Access' and complete the form.





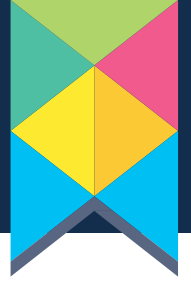
